

# To Defeat the Islamic Fascism of Iran and Turkey, We Must Delegitimize the Ideology

The rhetoric about the so-called "War on Terror" has led us down the wrong path for 20 years. Terrorism is a tactic. We are not at war with terror. Similarly, our fight is not against radical or extreme Islam. Aljazeera reports that "French authorities have said that Algerian footballer Youcef Atal was detained for questioning and will stand trial for sharing a social media post that purportedly encouraged violence against Jews.

In a statement on Friday, prosecutors said that police detained Atal, who plays for French club Nice, for questioning on Thursday as part of a probe into possible "justification of terrorism" over the post."

On the other hand, voters in Rochdale - Britain, in a mass move, pointed the finger at the Labour Party for disowning its candidate. The candidate had claimed that Israel was fully aware of the Hamas attack; nevertheless, allowed Hamas to do what it did. This unfounded comment raised hell. The Labour Party, not wanting to lose a coming up by-election (mid-term) and wanting to keep the momentum, immediately disowned him and announced that he (a Muslim) is no longer their candidate. The satiric side of this tragedy is that the Labour Party cannot remove the name and logo of the Party printed against the candidate's name on the ballot sheet, as all sheets have already been printed by the Election Office.

George Galloway, a leftist candidate who had a serious grudge against the Labour Party, took the opportunity and threw in his hat and won by a majority of 6000 votes. On his victory speech he named the leader of the Labour Party and said "Keir Starmer - this is for Gaza". The Labour Party, who had already enjoyed over 9000 majority, became fifth.

One wonders, now that majority of the people of Rochdale voted for this "outspoken" candidate (an antisemitic man - according to many Parties), does it mean that the voters are also antisemitic, or just anti-genocide? On the other hand, does it mean that those who did not vote for him, agree with bombing and killing unarmed Palestinian citizens?

Now a point of advice to all those who want to remove a dictator regime in their own countries: please do make sure the next regime is not as "democratic" as these regimes in Europe, otherwise you have jumped from the frying pan into the fire.
